# POKER BURNOUT

## OFFICIAL PROMOTIONAL RULES

1. Poker Burnout is a single deck card game played with a standard deck of cards.
2. The player is required to place a single Blind wager for Poker Burnout within the posted minimum and maximum table limits and on the designated spot.
3. Players are dealt three cards which they will have the option of folding and forfeiting their blind wager or placing an Ante wager of one, two or three times (1x, 2x or 3x) their Blind wager.
4. The players will receive three community cards making up the flop.
5. The player will have the option of folding their cards and forfeiting their Blind and Ante wagers or placing a Call bet that is equal to their Ante bet and discarding one of their three cards by placing it under the Kicker wager.
6. The player will receive two more community cards for the Turn and River.
7. A player wins if their hand forms a three of a kind or better using poker rankings to determine the relative rank of their hand.
8. The player loses if their hand is lower than three of a kind or better.
9. Kicker is an optional bonus bet placed in addition to the mandatory wager on Poker Burnout.
10. The Kicker bet considers the best hand possible among the player's three cards and is reconciled against the posted pay table, and paid regardless of the outcome on the base wagers for Poker Burnout.
11. The Blind bet considers the best hand possible among the player's two remaining cards and the five community cards making the best possible five card poker hand and is reconciled against the posted pay table.
12. Winning Ante and Call wagers are paid 1 to 1 (even money).
13. The dealer then follows house procedures for Poker Burnout.
14. The players may not show their cards or discuss their hands with the other players during the hand.
15. While reconciling the standard Blind, Ante and Call wagers, the dealer also reconciles the Kicker bonus bets.
  - a. If the player's hand qualifies for a payout, the dealer pays the player according to the posted pay table.
    - i. Notwithstanding to the payout odds on the approved pay table options and subject to gaming regulations, a casino licensee may establish a maximum aggregate amount that is payable per round or per hand. The maximum payout is posted on the table.
  - b. If the player's hand does not qualify for payouts, the dealer takes the players Kicker wager.
