<p>Smoke BBQ & Brew will reopen. Guests can dine in at physically distanced tables or pick up orders to-go. There are new menu items and breakfast will be available.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sunday-Thursday, 8 a.m.-9 p.m. • Friday-Saturday, 8 a.m.-11 p.m. • Bar will be open seven days a week from 11 a.m.-11 p.m. <p>Mino Wiisini will be open for to-go orders seven days a week.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 11 a.m.-2 a.m. <p>Traditions Buffet will be closed. The restaurant will be available for expanded seating. The buffet will not be set up, but guests are welcome to eat at physically distanced tables.</p> <p>Mustang Lounge will be open seven days a week, offering cocktail service on the casino floor. Regularly scheduled entertainment will resume with limited seating to ensure physical distancing.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 11 a.m.-1 a.m. 	<p>When you arrive at Shooting Star, your experience will be a little different. We are making every effort to keep you safe.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entrances will be monitored, and guests will be screened upon entering, including temperature checks. Masks are highly encouraged. Guests are asked to bring their own. If guests do not have a mask, Shooting Star will provide one. • STAR team members will wear masks for their safety and yours. <p>We are taking every effort to make sure it's easy to practice physical distancing.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Slot machines will be spaced to ensure physical distancing. • Look for signs to help you always stay 6 feet from other guests. • There will be limited table games with appropriate space between players. Players be asked to wear a mask and gloves, which will be provided. 	<p>If you aren't feeling well, stay home. The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) states that COVID-19 symptoms include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cough • Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing • Fever • Chills • Muscle pain • Sore throat • New loss of taste or smell <p>The CDC recommends wearing cloth face masks in public settings.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masks are highly encouraged. • Keep the mask on for the duration of your stay. • Only take your mask off for eating or drinking.



Eagles Landing non-smoking bar will be open seven days a week.

Shooting Star Casino will reopen the hotel with limited occupancy, as well as the RV Park and the Gift shop.

- Housekeeping will clean rooms with enhanced cleaning protocols after each guest checks out.
- The Gift Shop will be open seven days per week, 8 a.m.-10 p.m.

Concerts in the event center will not resume at this time.

- For cancelled concerts, ticket holders received a refund to their original form of payment.
- For rescheduled concerts, ticket holders get the first chance to purchase tickets for the new date.

The following Mahnomen venues, offerings and amenities will not reopen in this first phase. The following will stay closed until further notice:

- Sereniitee Spa
- Golden Eagle Bingo and teleconference bingo
- Poker
- ZONE8
- Traditions Buffet
- Pool
- Event Center

- Sanitation stations will be located throughout the property.
- The STAR team will frequently clean and sanitize high-touch areas during operating hours.

Deep cleanings will be conducted after hours at both the Mahnomen and Bagley locations.

- After hours at each facility allows the STAR team time to do a thorough job of heightened cleaning and disinfecting.

The STAR team has undergone training on new health and safety protocols. This includes:

- Proper use of PPE, importance of handwashing, properly cleaning and physical distancing.
- Each STAR team member is screened before they report for duty. If they aren't feeling well, they are sent home to rest until they feel healthy.

Because of the frequent contact with high touch surfaces and handling of chips and cards by team members and guests, it is important to practice good hygiene to prevent the spread of germs. Recommended practices include:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for 20 seconds.
- Use hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- Avoid touching your face.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue and then throw it in the trash.



Shooting Star Casino's Bagley location also will have limited occupancy and hours to make sure they are able to safely operate.

The Little Dipper Bar and Grill will reopen. Guests can dine in at physically distanced tables or pick up orders to go.

- Sunday-Thursday, 11 a.m.-7 p.m.
- Friday-Saturday, 11 a.m.- 10 p.m.
- The bar is open seven days a week, 11 a.m.-midnight
